TOTAL GRANTING: \$100,000

ECONOMIC SELF-SUFFICIENCY (ES): \$59,750 - 60%

LEADERSHIP (L): \$21,650 - 22%

HEALTH (H): \$18,600 - 18%

Bernie Lorenz Recovery, Inc./MECCA (ES) - \$2,000 toward operations of residential facility assisting women recovering from addictions to ensure ability to become self-sufficient, independent, successfully employed, and substance-free.

Iowa Homeless Youth Centers (ES) - \$7,500 toward operations for Lighthouse Host Home transitional shelter for homeless pregnant and parenting women ages 16-25 providing vocational, life skills, parenting, and education programs.

Mid- Iowa Sexual Abuse Response Team, Polk County Crisis and Advocacy Services (H) - \$5,800 to provide Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners for multidisciplinary emergency team responding to victims of sexual assault.

Shalom Zone Ministries (ES) - \$7,500 for support to ongoing delivery of community-based education and self-sufficiency training programs in for low-income women, children, and families.

Young Women's Resource Center (ES/L) - \$7,500 toward operations of agency providing gender-specific programming for young women ages 11-21.

AID Greater Des Moines (ES/L) - \$5,000 for peer advocate training program to reach women with or at risk for HIV.

Bidwell Riverside Community Center (ES) - \$7,500 to support the Garden of Eden educational project helping women and their families start small businesses, complete education, or find long-term employment.

Iowa Foster and Adoptive Parents Association (ES/H) - \$10,000 for partnership with Young Women's Resource Center to provide training for foster and adoptive parents of teenage girls.

Iowa Public Television Foundation (ES/L) - \$15,000 supporting "Enhanced Connections to Science" video productions offering hands-on educational activities led by female educators for students in grades 3-9.

ISED Ventures (ES) - \$7,500 for "You Can, Too!" financial literacy and asset-building education programs for women, girls, and families.

Mentor Iowa (ES/L) - \$3,000 in support of "Girl Power" networking group for 11-16 year old girls to provide education and mentoring on careers, physical and mental health, safety, and self-esteem.

Planned Parenthood of Greater Iowa (ES/H) - \$15,000 for targeted outreach activities to inform and assist low-income women in enrolling in and receiving free federally-funded family planning services.

YMCA of Greater Des Moines (L/H) - \$6,700 to provide “Girls on the Run” programming for 8 to 13-year-old girls to teach healthy lifestyles, leadership, self-esteem, and positive development.
