Valerie Plame

Until 2003, very few people knew her name. Valerie Plame was a career undercover CIA operative working to prevent the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction – specifically nuclear weapons.

Recruited by the CIA after her graduation from Penn State University, Plame was sent by the CIA to the London School of Economics in 1991, and later the College of Europe for a master's degree. She then began her assignment as an undercover "energy consultant."

During her career with the CIA, Plame managed top-secret covert programs to keep terrorists and rogue nation states from acquiring nuclear weapons. Her work involved senior-level decision making, recruiting foreign assets, managing multi-million-dollar budgets, briefing United States policymakers, and deploying resources across the globe. She was also involved in covert cyber operations and counterterrorism activities.

Her CIA career abruptly ended in 2003 with the political scandal that rocked the White House and was detailed in her *New York Times* bestselling memoir *FAIR GAME: MY LIFE AS A SPY, MY BETRAYAL BY THE WHITE HOUSE*, which was later released as a major motion picture. She continues sharing her expertise on national security issues while serving on various boards and think tanks.

Plame is an internationally recognized expert on cybersecurity, national security, nuclear proliferation, and women in intelligence. She has written for publications including TIME, Newsweek, CNN, and the Huffington Post, and she ran for Congress to represent New Mexico's Third Congressional District.

Chrysalis is honored to host Valerie Plame as she shares her experience as a woman in a male-dominated field and in moving from action to activism.

For over 35 years, the Chrysalis Foundation has worked to ensure that girls and women in Greater Des Moines have the resources, support, and opportunities they need to be successful and independent. We focus on Polk, Warren, and Dallas Counties.



The Chrysalis mission is to invest in the safety, security, education, and economic empowerment of girls and women in our community. We do this in partnership with agencies and services in Polk, Warren, and Dallas Counties through grants, community education, and donor support.

As a public charity, all Chrysalis operating expenses are funded by a permanent endowment, allowing **100% of community support to be invested in community agencies and organizations** serving the needs and concerns of girls and women. Community support provides funding for the following programs:

Chrysalis Community Grants Program. Annually awarding funds, emergency support, training, and professional development to nonprofits focused on the Chrysalis mission. Chrysalis also provides Client Emergency Funds and Rapid Response grants for unplanned, unanticipated needs. This year, Chrysalis supports 34 nonprofit agencies.

Chrysalis After-School Program. Serves girls and young women in 5th through 8th grade in Des Moines area schools each year. There is no charge to any participant in Chrysalis After-School, which has operated every year since its creation in 1998, including through months of the pandemic. Each year, Chrysalis After-School supports up to 500 participants in over 30 local schools.

GirlPower High School Peer Mentoring Program. Year-long training, coaching, and leadership development for high school and college age young women who mentor younger girls in Chrysalis After-School programs. Since this program began, 58 young women have participated as mentors.

Chrysalis Scholarship Program. Ensures post-secondary education for young women who have participated in Chrysalis After-School programs; 204 scholarships have been awarded since 2014.

Chrysalis offers additional opportunities to learn, network, and advocate for girls and women through the **Women's Alliance**, a coalition of grant partners, stakeholders, and nonprofit organizations collaborating with Chrysalis on common issues, education, and advocacy.

The Chrysalis INSPIRED Event, Coffee with Chrysalis, Summer Celebration, and other annual and unique events raise funds and awareness about issues and concerns of women and girls.
